

SAMPLE PARTNERSHIP ACTIVITIES

Apprenticeship Programs provide specific occupational job training within a structured program.

Career Education Programs are specialized events to provide exposure to and awareness of career alternatives.

Guest Speakers from an organization visit a school system to provide information about their business/industry.

Job Shadowing allows students to observe professionals at their places of work to learn about the skills required for future careers.

Mentorship Programs provide role models to assist students in developing job skills and career direction.

Skill Development includes curriculum changes or special events designed to develop specific skills that are needed in today's growing businesses.

Sponsorship Programs provide financial assistance to students and/or schools for industry-specific career development activities.

Student Internships / Cooperative Education Programs are mutually beneficial partnerships for businesses/industries and students, which allow students to gain academic credits or co-op education work experiences related to their courses of study.

Teacher Internships provide educators with first hand experience in a corporate or industrial setting.

Tutoring Programs match corporate personnel with students for assistance in needed subjects.

Workplace Exposure / Tours provide direct experience for students to the business/industry, its facilities and its personnel.

Workshops on a particular business/industry provide exposure to area students on employment opportunities.
